## WHY DO THE COURSE?

If you're unemployed or self-employed this course is free. If you're employed the government picks up 90% of the cost. So either way it is a great opportunity whether you're new to construction or want to upskill. You'll have an NHSS card, EUSR registration, a NOCN certificate, Setting Out knowledge, experience of drone use, and Japanese Knotweed awareness. There are great job opportunities following successful completion.

## COST OF COURSE

- If you're unemployed or Self-employed the course is fully funded by the government
- Small to medium sized employers, who have new related roles for their employees or wish them to upskill, pay 10% of the training cost – the rest is funded by the government:
  - £348.50 inc. VAT (10% of the £3484 inc. VAT training cost).
- Large employers (250+), who have new related roles for their employees, pay 30% of the training cost – the rest is funded by the government:
  - £1045.50 inc. VAT (30% of the £3484 inc. VAT training cost).
